

Candy Tube Piping Designs And Decorations

Candy Tubes (purchase at chocolatecraftkits.com)

Non-stick baking paper or clean tracing paper

Templates – use ours on the last page or think up your own ideas!



1. Prepare candy tube by warming. Use Hot Water Method for consistent and safe results: Place tube in very hot water 5 to 10 minutes until entirely melted. Cut a small opening at the tip and if the candy does not come out, run hot water over the tip with the opening pointing down until unclogged. Always dry tube after it has been in water. Repeat as needed.

2. Put the baking or waxed paper over the design you want to make. Pipe onto the paper, creating the pattern in candy.

3. To allow for spread, make the lines thinner than you want them.

4. When hard, take the design off the paper by sliding a metal spatula underneath and evenly lifting design off paper.

DECORATING TIP: Trace a message or design and transfer to a chocolate box or cake.

Candy Tube Butterfly

Non-stick baking paper or clean tracing paper

Butterfly template – use ours on the last page or think up your own ideas!

Spatula • Plates



1. See Candy Tube piping directions on first page
2. Place non-stick baking paper or clean tracing paper on top of butterfly template
3. Pipe the outside lines of the wings
4. Pipe a pattern inside the wings, making sure the lines are connected.
5. Let wings harden, then prop the wings at an angle with a small space in the center by leaning them against edges of two plates
6. Connect the two wings by piping the body in the middle



DECORATING TIP: Candy Tube Butterfly is a good chocolate box decoration or cake decoration.



Candy Tube Snowflake Ornament

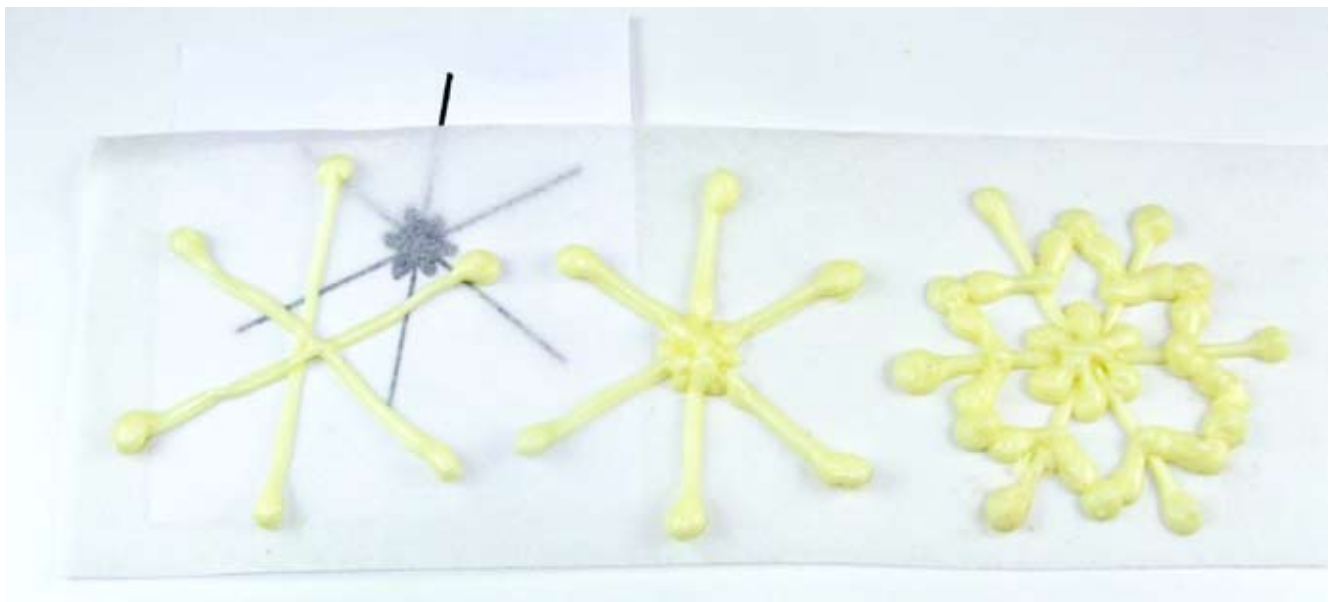

Non-stick baking paper or clean tracing paper

Snowflake template – use ours on the last page or think up your own ideas!

Spatula • Ribbon

1. See Candy Tube piping directions on first page
 2. Place non-stick baking paper or clean tracing paper on top of snowflake template
 3. Pipe the three longest crossed lines of the template
 4. Fill in the center of each triangle part of the snowflake center to make it strong
 5. Pipe any design you want (every snowflake is different!). Keep the lines strong by overlapping them; thin places break easily.
 6. Thread ribbon on top for hanging as an ornament, or place flat on candy box or cake

Candy Tube Standing Chocolate Tree

Non-stick baking paper or clean tracing paper

Tree template – use ours on the last page or think up your own ideas!

Spatula • Plate

2. Place non-stick baking paper or clean tracing paper on top of tree template
3. Pipe 4-6 tree sides, fill them in or leave them in outline.



4. When dry, lay one tree shape down and prop one up next to it along edge of plate, flat sides together.
5. Attach the center lines to make the tree trunk with Candy Tube
6. Stand up 2 or more pairs of partial trees together and connect at the trunk with more piping.
7. Let harden, then decorate your Chocolate Craft Kit House with your tree..



Candy Tube Piping Design Templates



Enlarge designs to desired final size. Put wax paper on top and trace design with Candy Tube.
